Malaria in Namibia is once again a forgotten disease. Drive Against Malaria (DAM) helps bring back attention about Malaria in Namibia with headlines in the Namib Times. Even though recent reports show that malaria mortality rates decreased in the centre- and the south of the country, the health sector may not be complacent. The communities in the far north are still hit hard by Malaria. Most Malaria-endemic areas in the north are still far from achieving universal coverage with lifesaving malaria interventions. Many bottlenecks threaten to slow down the attention and the spread – further south - of this complicated enemy. According to WHO Namibia, Malaria is spreading further south from the border of Angola. The fear is severe complications due to a lack of resistance within the population. The presence of DAM helps put the deadly disease back on the political agenda, before the situation in the rest of the country is getting out of control.
